The central exhibition venue, **Atelierhaus Monbijoupark** on Oranienburger Strasse comprises exhibition space on a 13-metre high platform, hovering over the building and a bunker. Work will also be shown at **KW Institute of Contemporary Art** in the large hall and on all four floors. *based in Berlin* will also move into the entire 800 sqm eastern wing of the **Nationalgalerie im Hamburger Bahnhof**. The **Neue Berliner Kunstverein n.b.k.** is presenting the exhibition on its ground floor and in its first floor showroom, and the **Berlinische Galerie** will contribute 160 sqm of exhibition space to *based in Berlin* for a special solo presentation. The exhibition is curated by Angelique Campens, Fredi Fischli, Magdalena Magiera, Jakob Schillinger and Scott Cameron Weaver.
